

## The IT industry

International comparisons and statistics divide the information technology industry into production and services. The services category is further subdivided into wholesale, telecommunications services, and software and consultancy.<sup>1</sup>

### Manufacture

- 31.30 Manufacture of insulated wire and cable
- 32.10 Manufacture of electronic valves and tubes and other electronic components

- 32.30 Manufacture of television and radio receivers, sound or video recording or reproducing apparatus and associated goods
